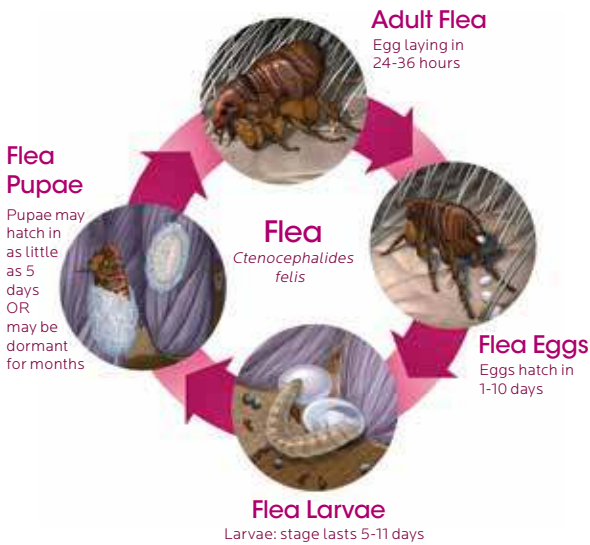

Flea Life Cycle



Thousands of fleas can quickly infest your home, biting and causing skin irritation to pets and humans alike.

Fleas have four life cycle stages: egg, larva, pupa and adult. Eggs can hatch in just 1 to 10 days.¹ Fleas take blood from your cat and can cause a number of problems:²

- > Fleas may cause your cat to be extremely uncomfortable causing them to scratch, chew, bite and experience fur loss or restlessness.²
- > Fleas are the source of flea allergy dermatitis (FAD), a common veterinary skin condition in which secondary infections can also develop.²
- > Severe infestations may cause anemia, iron-deficiency and in small cats, even death.²

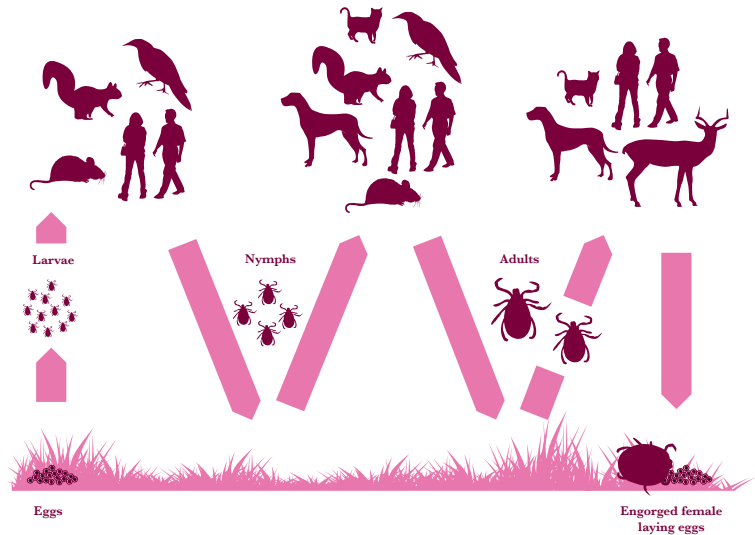

Ticks can be a problem

Ticks have four life cycle stages: egg, larva, nymph and adult.¹ The complete life cycle can take from 3 months to 2 years or longer to complete.² Hard ticks are the most common types of ticks to infest cats.¹ There is a tick species active for at least part of the year in every region of the United States.¹



The life cycle can last from a few months to two years



Ticks can carry many serious diseases,¹ including

- > Lyme disease
- > Ehrlichiosis
- > Rocky Mountain spotted fever
- > Anaplasmosis
- > Babesiosis
- > Hepatozoonosis

- > Soft, collapsible reservoir helps the pet owner control application.



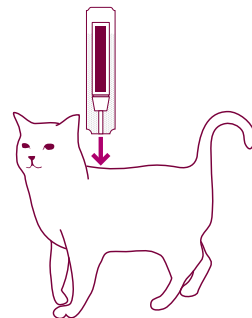
Application Instructions

How to Open:

1. Remove product tubes from the package.
2. Separate one tube from the others. Hold the tube with notched end pointing up and away from the face and body. Use scissors to cut off the narrow end at the notches along the line.

How to Apply:

1. Invert tube over cat and use open end to part cat's hair.
2. Squeeze tube firmly to apply all of the solution to the cat's skin as a spot to the cat's back between the shoulder blades.
